The Significance of Letters


1. The stroke is often called a horn and Hebrew scholars say that if a “Yod” is lacking the horn then it becomes invalid. Therefore, Torah scrolls that are found lacking even one horn or stroke would be cast out. As a result, Yahshua makes this statement:

MattithYAHU 5:19 Whoever therefore breaks one of the least of these commandments, and teaches men so, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever does and teaches *them*, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

Numerical value: 10

Messiah Yahshua proclaimed **“I tell you the truth, until heaven and earth disappear, not one yod, nor the least stroke of a pen, will by any means disappear from the Torah until everything is accomplished. (Matthew 5:18)”**

“Yod” speaks of the humility of totally surrendering to the hand of Yahweh.

“Now the man Moshe was very meek, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth. (Numbers 12:3)”

It has the numerical value of ten speaking of Yahweh’s creativity. The Rabbis teach: “HaShem created the Universe with the letters ‘yod’ and ‘hey’ which form the first syllable of the Divine Name, Yah.

The Completion of a Monumental Quest



Finally Hebrew became the official language of the Jews in Israel in 1922. This signalled the completion of monumental quest began by Eliezer to see Hebrew become the language of his emerging Nation. Only one month later in December of 1922 Eliezer Ben Yehuda died at the age of 64 of the tuberculosis that he had battled since his Paris days. He was buried on the Mount of Olives in Jerusalem in a funeral attended by 30,000 people. In 1908 Ben Yehuda had written "for everything there is needed but one wise, clever & active man with the initiative to devote all his energies to it and the matter will progress." Surely the part he played in the revival of Israel and the Hebrew language cannot be overstated.
